This scholarship is not affiliated with SHS or the Sonora Area Foundation.

2024 Yosemite Community Scholarship. The deadline to apply is April 15, 2024. Eligibility includes:

1. Graduating high school at the end of the 2023/2024 academic year.

AND

2. At least one of the following: One parent or guardian has worked for at least 6 of the previous 12 months within the boundaries of Yosemite National Park, the El Portal Administrative Site, or the NPS office in Mariposa for either NPS, YHS (Aramark), TAAG, YC, NB, or at the park schools of El Portal, Yosemite Valley, or Wawona.
