Policy updated to reflect the California Department of Education's (CDE) Youth Suicide-Prevention Guidelines for California Schools which include identifying factors of high-risk behaviors, and helping students identify depression and self-destructive behaviors. Regulation updated to include the crisis intervention procedures.
