10.H. First Reading with Consideration to Waive Additional Readings and Approve BP & AR 5123-Promotion/Acceleration/Retention

Policy revised to remove requirements for passing the state high school exit examination, and clarify the parameters which will be used in determining a student's retention. The new regulation states guidelines for retention or interventions for support of students in lieu of retention.

10.I. First Reading with Consideration to Waive Additional Readings and Approve AR 5144.2-Suspension and Expulsion/Due Process (Students with Disabilities)

Regulation updated to address procedures required when disciplining students receiving special education related services. (Note: CSBA has no BP recommendations)

10.J. First Reading with Consideration to Waive Additional Readings and Approve BP & AR 6159.1-Procedural Safeguards and Complaints for Special Education

Regulation and policy updated to specify when the procedural safeguards notice will be given to the parents/guardians of student with disabilities. Regulation also updated to reflect new law that states a parent/guardian may revoke consent for special education related services for their child.
